AROSA (Switzerland)

July 12th to 18th, 2009

General Information:

Seminar directed by Jöri Murk, Langnau a/Albis (Switzerland)

These courses are for adults and teens, who are playing for at least 6 months or advanced panflute players.

Classes: Monday through Friday, 9 AM to 12:10 PM and 2:30 PM to 5:40 PM, 5 lessons per day, each one 50 minutes. Based on request of former students we do not allow to visit classes during their operation to avoid disturbance of participating students. We are not offering private lessons.

Once registration is completed the participants are divided into groups according to their level.

Registration deadline: May 31, 2009. At the end of June we will issue the grouping selection in writing.

You can choose **5 lessons** in total. The seminar costs are independent of the number of lessons taken. If you are not interested in taking all five lessons offered, you could use the spare time to practice (no reduced rates).

Course description:

1a. Interpretation and techniques in playing the panflute (rum. folklore): (Beginners and advanced) **One lesson each day.** Based on melodies of "ROMANZEN" you will be taught to determine which playing techniques should be applied. Moreover, you will be introduced into interpretation methods, using techniques such as body positioning, breath control, panflute positioning, tongue articulation, halftone, vibrato and embellishments.

1b. Interpretation and technique of well known Doinas: **One lesson each day.** (Beginners and advanced). Based on melodies of the new "DOINAS" you will be taught to determine which playing techniques should be applied for playing with feelings and much vibrato.

1c. Technique: **One lesson each day.** (Beginners and advanced) You will be introduced into fundamental techniques of panfluteplaying with the book "10 Minuten.Training" of Peder Rizzi.

1d. Interpretation of classics: **One lesson each day.** (only advanced) You will be introduced into interpretation methods, of classical music. **By yourself prepared melodies** out of DIVERTIMENTO I, II and III of Peder Rizzi

1e. Interpretation and techniques in playing the panflute (classics): One lesson each day. (Beginners and advanced) Based on "LEICHTE KLASSISCHE STÜCKE" and "8 KLASSISCHE STÜCKE FÜR PANFLÖTE" you will be taught to determine which playing techniques should be applied.

1f. Interpretation and techniques in playing the panflute (classics, Folklore and Pop): One lesson each day. (Beginners and advanced) Based on Classical, Folklore and Pop melodies, you will be taught to determine which playing techniques should be applied.

2a. Additional study lesson with group instructor: In an additional lesson you gradually enhance skills obtained in course #1 under the guidance of a group supervisor.

2b. Bass-Panflute Course: Here you learn in **two daily lessons** to play the Bass-Panflute. *Instructor: Joerg Frei*

or

2c. Blues Course: Here you learn in **two daily lessons** to play Blues-Rhythm-Melodies. *Instructor: Joerg Frei*

3a. Correpitition (rehearsal with prepared melodies, accompanied by another instrument): One lesson each day. In correpitition you work with melodies which you have already practiced and are able to play. You learn to express a melody with accompaniment, such as when it comes to live performance. It is absolutely necessary to bring along with you all sheet music for accompaniment used in the lessons.

4. Panflutechoir: There is one group for beginners and advanced players. You rehearse pieces for several voices, which will be performed at the end of the seminar.

Ciolac Gheorghe studied at the Academy of Music "Gheorghe Dima" in Klausenburg and graduated in 1973 with a music diploma. As a professional musician he performed with various formations and instructed at the Music Academy in Fürth, Germany.

Ersek Rudi musician and entertainer from Czechia

Joerg Frei, Käthi Kaufmann, Umberto Miotti and Claudia De Franco learned to play the panflute by Joeri Murk and are teaching since many years at different DAJOERI Panflute Schools.

Hoerler Bernhard studied at the musicacademy Zurich with Dr. Bernhard Billeter. Since 1984 he is organist at the catholic church of Oberengstringen and since 1994 he is the main organist of the catholic church of Dietikon.

Jantea Julian is a Rumanian accordeonist and plays in different groups.

Inauen Mathias is organist and director of a church choir in Lucerne, Switzerland.

Kipfer Karl musician and musicteacher at the musicschool in Zofingen

Koella Felix is musician, bandleader and accompanies many different formations.

Masanz Georg is organist in Nussbaumen (AG) and Kirchdorf. He is professor for organ improvisation at the Musikhochschule Lucerne. Through extensive experience with various panflute players, he developed a very thorough understanding and affinity for this instrument.

Micu Jon is a professional musician (taragot and singer) from Rumania. He plays in different ensembles all over Europe.

Monnin Cédric is a Swiss panflutist who was taught by Gheorghe Zamfir and Simion Stanciu.

Murk Joeri is teacher, the founder of the DAJOERI Panflute Schools and of the DAJOERI Panflute manufacturing company.

Nechifor Radu, a Rumanian panflute player, studied music (panflute) at the Musicacademy in Sibiu, where he graduated best in his class. Afterwards he continues his studies with Gheorghe Zamfir at the conservatory in Bucarest.

Rizzi Peder accomplished his music studies in 1982 as a clarinetist and he won the 1st prize for music pedagogics. Since 1983 he is instructor at the teachers seminar in Kuesnacht and since 1987 at the conservatory of Zurich. He performs in different groups and as a solist.

Schenk Jakob is a musician. He was student of Nicolae Pîrvu at the „Academy of Arts“ in Amsterdam.

Schwander Lise-Anne is instructing in various DAJOERI Panflute Schools in Switzerland and is conducting the Zuerich panflute choir.

Dr. Tisera Gregorio is musician and singer, born in Argentina, speaks fluently german and english. He plays the guitarre and typical southamerican instruments like charango, quena, siku, zampona and bombo leguero. Here you learn to understand the most typical aspects of the southamerican music from Mexico to Argentina with different historical, ethnical and cultural backgrounds.

Wettstein Werner is a Swiss panflute teacher with experiences of many years.
